A key member of the President's senior leadership team, the VPAA is Logan's chief academic officer and holds primary responsibility for the development, coordination and implementation of the curriculum as well as the recruitment and retention of faculty and the management of academic support services. The VPAA supervises the Associate Vice President of Academic Affairs, and together they manage the institution's academic operation. The academic affairs offices supervise: Division Chairs, Academic Advisors, Director of Institutional Analysis, Dean of Chiropractic Affairs, University Programs, Dean of Student Affairs, Registrar, Director of Financial Aid and Multicultural Affairs. The VPAA reports directly to the President.

The new VPAA will exhibit an aspirational leadership style, champion Logan's commitment to the synergy of theory and practice, and inspire faculty, students and administrative colleagues to engage in interdisciplinary programming. S/he will have demonstrated success in administration, ideally in a health-related field; experience leading a faculty with diverse backgrounds and pedagogical approaches; an understanding of and support for faculty research and development; a demonstrated commitment to undergraduate and graduate education; in-depth knowledge of accreditation practices; experience managing web-based/online educational offerings; outstanding communication skills; and a collegial and decisive management style that will build strong relationships with faculty, students, administrators, alumni, and external constituencies.

In addition to the qualities described above, the ideal candidate will have academic and/or professional qualifications which may be appropriate for a tenured appointment at the University/College of Chiropractic.

Logan was established in 1935. Today, it is a private, coeducational university/college of chiropractic. Offerings include the internationally recognized flagship Logan College of Chiropractic. The University programs include undergraduate baccalaureate degrees in human biology and life sciences plus a master's of science in sports science and rehabilitation. Logan is located on a lovely 112-acre wooded hilltop campus in Chesterfield, MO, 20 minutes west of downtown St. Louis, and was recently rated among the nation's most beautiful campuses by MSNBC.

Logan's 101 faculty members serve 1,080 undergraduate and graduate students. The University/College of Chiropractic's superb facilities include state-of-the-art "smart classrooms" equipped with the latest technology and symposium-style seating; technique, science and research laboratories; the recently renovated Learning Resource Center; Health Centers; the Science and Research Center; the William M.
